Test your pillow. If you bought your pillow in 2022, it's already old. The National Sleep Foundation suggests replacing your pillow every one to two years. 2. _____ "When your brain is sending pain signals, it can't send sleep signals," says Dr Michael J Breus, a clinical psychologist and sleep specialist.

Get an hour of sunlight each day. Morning sunlight is important for good sleep. "It stops melatonin production in your brain, which helps relieve the sleepy morning feeling," Breus says. It also sets a mental timer to produce melatonin, the so-called sleep hormone, that evening. Aim for 15 to 30 minutes of direct light first and two 15-minute outdoor breaks during the day. 3.

Skip salty snacks before bed. In a Japanese study, researchers followed 321 patients with high-salt diets and sleep issues for 12 weeks.

Handwriting notes in class might seem outdated as smartphones and other digital technology cover every aspect of learning across schools and universities. But a steady stream of research continues to suggest that taking notes the traditional way is still the best way to learn, especially for young children. And now scientists are finally zeroing in on why.

The new research, by Audrey van der Meer and Ruud van der Weel at the Norwegian University of Science and Technology (NTNU), builds on a foundational 2014 study suggesting that people taking notes by computer were typing without thinking. "It kind of goes in through your ears and comes out through your fingertips, but you don't process the incoming information," Audrey says. But when taking notes by hand, it's often impossible to write everything down; students have to actively pay attention to the incoming information and process it—prioritize it, consolidate it and try to relate it to things they've learned before. This conscious action of building onto existing knowledge can make it easier to stay engaged and grasp new concepts.

To understand specific brain activity differences during the two note-taking approaches, the researchers sewed electrodes (电极) into a hairnet with 256 sensors that recorded the brain activity of 36 students as they wrote or typed 15 words from the game Pictionary that were displayed on a screen.

When students wrote the words by hand, the sensors detected widespread connectivity across many brain regions. Typing, however,

led to minimal activity, if any, in the same areas. Handwriting set off connection patterns covering visual regions, which receive and process sensory information, and the motor cortex (运动皮层). The latter handles body movement and sensorimotor integration, which helps the brain use environmental inputs to inform a person's next action.

Sophia Vinci-Booher, an assistant professor of educational brain science at Vanderbilt University, says, "People may not realize when they materialize something by writing or drawing it, this strengthens the concept and helps it stick in their memory."

All three of my children were subject matter experts before they even left primary school. My eldest son memorized every statistic on every football trading card he got his hands on. His brother knew hundreds of car makes and models by heart. And I'm sure that my daughter—a huge One Direction fan—remembered more facts about the band than they did! The experience of becoming an expert can bring long-term benefits for learning—and it's never too late. "Having a specialist subject helps you learn anything," says our memory expert, Jonathan Hancock. "There are good reasons for all of us to do a spot of specialist learning."

It schools our observation: a vital first step to remember. Children are particularly good at seeing slight differences—like my younger son and his cars—then using them to organize information and inspire recall. But focused learning like this can push anyone to start noticing key details—ready to remember them.

It gives us a mental framework (框架), to which we can attach unrelated ideas. Even when his trading-card period was over, my son often linked new numbers with stored-away sports statistics. Your own area of interest might help you by suggesting soundalike words for people's names, or letting you "map" travel directions.

It gets us learning in a variety of ways, often with the help of all our senses. My daughter's pop knowledge was a rich mix of music, dances and colourful costumes, with

precise facts. Burying yourself in a subject boosts your brain to work at its best.

It restores our confidence to remember. We get to see what a difference it makes to be interested in something, to build up information in layers (层次), and to keep refreshing, testing and showing off what we know. It can give all our learning a boost.

Why not pick a topic that interests you, find some books, take a course, join a club... and enjoy becoming at least an entry-level expert? Even a short spell of specialist study can reawaken learning skills that used to feel like child's play.
